WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Individuals and families who made less than \$55,000 in 2018; no income requirement for seniors or those with disabilities (providing the return is not too complex).

WHAT TO BRING TO A VITA SITE

- **Copy of last year's tax return is REQUIRED.**
- Valid photo ID for yourself and/or your spouse.
- **Social Security cards or ITIN cards for you, your spouse, and dependents.**
- Birthdates for you, your spouse, and dependents.
- Wage and earnings statements from all employers (Form W-2 or 1099-MISC).
- Interest and dividend statements from banks (Form 1099-INT or 1099-DIV).
- Affordable Care Act statements (Form 1095-A, 1095-B or 1095-C).
- Social Security Statement (SSA-1099), Education Expenses (1098-T), Pensions (1099 R) and Unemployment Statement (1099-G) if applicable.
- Other relevant information about income and expenses, i.e., donations made, including those to schools, educational expenses, home interest, property taxes & medical expenses for those who will be able to itemize.
- Total amount paid for day care and the day care providers' tax identification number.
- For Direct Deposit - bank routing numbers and account numbers.
- Copy of last year's tax return.
- **If filing joint, both you and your spouse must be present to sign the return.**
